I got stuck in from day one attending clinics covering a range of head and neck cancers as well as facial reconstruction cases. I was in theatre on a daily basis and got to see numerous procedures including hair transplants, neck dissections, abdominoplasties and facial soft tissue and bone reconstruction from tumours. I scrubbed into many and got to assist in cases involving lymphoedema and large fibula flaps. This provided a great opportunity to see the range of plastic surgery procedures. The registrars and consultants were always keen to teach which proved invaluable in the complex procedures conducted.

I was also able to attend the national breast reconstruction meeting (BRASCON) with faculty from all over the world presenting and providing valuable insight into breast surgery and reconstruction.
